

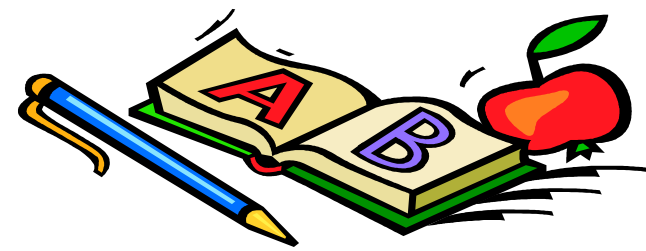
Individual Education Plan

- *The individual educational plan (IEP) documents the services required to meet student's needs. The Individual with Disabilities Education Act of 2004 (IDEA) governs services provided to students with disabilities **who attend public school.** School districts must follow established procedures to identify and evaluate students who are suspected of having a disability.*
- *An IEP is a **public school document** and may be used when converting to a Services Plan for parentally placed private school students*



Services Plan

*A Services Plan (SP) is developed and implemented to the extent appropriate for each **private school student** with a disability who has been designated to receive special education and related services offered by the school district. The SP must be developed by a team and reviewed at least annually.*



IEP vs. Services Plan

- *Children with disabilities enrolled in public schools are entitled to FAPE and must receive the full range of services under IDEA Part B that are necessary to meet the child's individual needs through a developed **Individual Education Plan (IEP)**.*
- **Services Plans** *are limited and only provide the services determined by the school district. PPPSS are not entitled to FAPE in the private schools*
