

TRANSITION CONTINUUM

for Students with Disabilities seeking a Standard Diploma Via ACCESS Points

Community Based Instruction (CBI)

- ◆ May be part of any ESE Course
- ◆ Extension of classroom learning
- ◆ Promotes transfer of skills to community
- ◆ student directed in alignment with Florida Standards
- ◆ May include focus in Education/training, Employment, or Independent Living
- ◆ Coordinated by school based Middle School or High School staff

Career Preparation

- ◆ 9th grade
- ◆ Self-determination and self-advocacy
- ◆ Career Planning, Career Exploration



- ◆ Students will explore careers and occupations
- ◆ Students will learn about community and agency resources
- ◆ Students will learn about effective work habits

Community Base Vocational Education (CBVE)

- ◆ 10-12 grades
- ◆ Specific to Career Experiences
- ◆ Unpaid job exploration and work experience
- ◆ Promotes general work skills and habits
- ◆ Increase competency and fluency



- ◆ Focus on 22 general work skills as outlined by the U.S. Department of Labor
- ◆ Typically 2 to 3 hours 4 x weekly at one of 70 partnering sites
- ◆ 5:1 ratio of full time staff to student

Post High School Programs

- ◆ Must be 18 or older
- ◆ Have met diploma requirements
- ◆ Inclusive instruction in business setting
- ◆ TIEP team has indicated a need for a Structured Work Study
- ◆ Unpaid skill development and work experience
- ◆ Promotes general work skills and habits



- ◆ Students must apply to defer to participate in "structured work study"
- ◆ Students are fully immersed in business environment
- ◆ Transportation provided by OCPS
- ◆ Students responsible for their own lunch
- ◆ 5:1 ratio of full time staff to students

Career Placement

- ◆ Students participate in paid work experience with appropriate supports
- ◆ Transportation NOT provided by OCPS
- ◆ Students monitored by ESE teacher



Project SEARCH



- ◆ 9 month intensive internship within inclusive business setting
- ◆ Have met diploma requirements
- ◆ Have been determined eligible for Vocational Rehabilitation Services
- ◆ Unpaid skill development and work experience with expectation for employment

Employment or Postsecondary Education/Training
