

Construction Update News from Orange County Public Schools

Millions saved as building projects close-out

The Facilities Services Department of Orange County Public School tabulated the total cost of nine recent construction projects and the budget savings totaled more than \$9 million. The work included relief schools, portable replacement projects and comprehensive renovations. The budget savings at close-out were in addition to \$140 million trimmed from construction estimates identified in last



September's Capital Outlay Budget approved by the school board.

"We are constantly in the pursuit of saving construction dollars without impacting the quality of our educational facilities and programs," said Superintendent Ronald Blocker. "We are taking a very close look at all expenses to determine where we can save money and return the savings to the capital program."

"Through the budget reevaluation process we have been able to fine tune the costs of our building program," said

Chief Facilities Officer Bob Proie. "Whatever savings we can squeeze out of a project without impacting the quality of the classrooms and school facilities. provides additional money to build more quality classrooms in the future. The savings so far on these projects would be enough to create an additional 25 permanent classrooms or about half of a brand new elementary school!"
