



## Orange schools to hold first-ever custodial job fair

Orange County Public Schools will be hosting the first-ever Facilities Department Custodial Job Fair from 9 to 3 p.m. on Wednesday, June 10.

A recent Facilities initiative to centralize custodial services, including the hiring of all custodians, makes a job fair necessary for the first time. Until recently, custodians were hired by individual schools.

The changes put all custodians – over 1,000 employees – under a single management structure while also standardizing work practices, training, equipment and cleaning products. There are currently about 50 openings.

The changes are already helping the district save money and improve service and efficiency at the 185 schools and support facilities served by custodians in Orange County Public Schools. The initiative will also increase the use of sustainable, "green" products and practices.
