Schools in Orlando, Apopka, Horizon West to hold Sneak Peeks

Alumni will walk the halls of a new Tangelo Park Elementary next week alongside community members, parents and students. The school, built in 1960, is one of seven schools opening to students August 15 that are either new, replacements or comprehensive renovations. Five of them, including Tangelo Park, will hold sneak peek events next week. Tangelo Park is a replacement, Bay Lake Elementary in Horizon West is new, and Lockhart, Dream Lake and Riverside elementaries are comprehensive renovations. At Tangelo Park, college flags decorate the halls, a reminder of the promise of the Rosen Foundation Scholarships, which cover full tuition for Tangelo Park students who graduate high school.
