Six Orange County elementary schools dedicate new buildings

Six Orange County Public Schools facilities that have been renovated, replaced or opened as new in Fall 2015 will be holding dedication ceremonies to celebrate with their communities.

While each event will have its own special flavor, all will feature ribbon-cuttings and student participation. Superintendent Barbara Jenkins, School Board Chairman Bill Sublette and area board members are among the dignitaries who will participate.

All of the schools have been upgraded to a district standard that includes a single, secured entrance, wiring for one-to-one devices, closed-circuit TV studios for student use, audio enhancement in the classrooms and other spaces, and interactive projectors and screens.

Each new, renovated or replaced school includes administrative offices, classrooms, a multipurpose space/cafeteria, media center, kitchen, art and music labs, computer lab, parking lots, covered walkways, play areas, outdoor activity spaces and parent drop-off loops.

The total cost of the work was approximately \$110,400,000. The district plans to open eight new, renovated or replacement schools in Fall 2016 and 15 in Fall 2017.
