The Orange County School Board on Tuesday voted to spend about \$590,000 to change the design of Oak Ridge High School's stadium. The school has been undergoing a school renovation.

Under the new plan, the school's old, 2,250-seat stadium will be renovated, instead of replacing it with a new stadium that would seat 1,250. The change would make the stadium's size more comparable to other recent high school projects.

The board agreed to amend its contract with SchenkelShultz Architecture, spending about \$103,000 in additional design fees. The changes will also mean \$488,000 in additional construction costs.
