School Construction and Maintenance

Projects 2020-21

A project at **Acceleration East** to have their main building re-roofed and rooftop heating, ventilation and air conditioning units replaced is underway and will be complete in September 2020. In addition, security fencing is being replaced.

A capital renewal project at **Blankner School** to replace roofing and heating, ventilation and air conditioning campus-wide, exterior lighting, exterior painting of the main building and the security camera system was completed in August 2019. The gymnasium got new gutters and downspouts, exterior repairs and paint. A tot lot playground shade structure was installed in June 2020. The track is set to be replaced in the fall of 2021. Interior painting campus-wide is scheduled for 2021.

At **Boone High**, a new Performing Arts Center was completed for the 2019-20 school year. A replacement of the gym was complete in August 2020 and the renovation of the cafeteria will be complete in October 2020. Interior repainting of the remaining buildings on campus are scheduled for completion in 2020. In addition, the softball field is set to be regraded in October 2020 and baseball field lighting will be completed in 2020. The campus also wrapped up in 2019 a capital renewal project that includes roof and fire alarm system replacement and rekeying campus-wide, and renovations in buildings 100, 200 and 300 including repainting, renovation of group bathrooms, plumbing improvements, renovation of the heating, ventilation and air conditioning system and new acoustical ceilings and LED lighting. The site for Boone HS was refreshed through an annual City of Orlando "Greenup" program to refurbish plant beds, pull weeds, and other beautification actions for the 2019-20 school year. OCPS provided mulch for this project.

A Curb Appeal project was held at **Cherokee School** in November 2019.

At **Conway Elementary**, a tot lot shade structure were completed in January 2020. Replacement of air conditioning chillers is scheduled for 2021.

A Curb Appeal project was held at **Conway Middle** in December 2019. A tot lot playground shade structure was installed in 2020. Replacement of the gymnasium air conditioning system and chilled water pumps is scheduled for 2021.

At **Cypress Creek High**, the track was rubberized and field events were refreshed in 2019. New softball and baseball field lighting is set for completion in December 2020. Auditorium renovations have been completed.

At the **Food and Nutrition Administration Building**, minor renovations to improve utilization of training classrooms will be completed in 2021.

At **Freedom High**, a restroom for the early childhood program is scheduled for completion in September 2020. A project to improve the school's heating, ventilation and air conditioning system and controls is set to be completed in October 2020. New baseball and softball lighting is scheduled to be finished in 2020. Installation of the new rubberized track and improved field events areas is ongoing and will be completed in 2021.

At **Freedom Middle**, a cafeteria sound system was completed in August 2019; an upgrade of the stage lighting is underway. Renewal of the air conditioning chillers is scheduled for 2021.

At **Hunter's Creek Elementary**, water bottle fillers were installed in 2020. A tot lot playground shade structure was installed in June 2020. Interior painting campus-wide is scheduled for 2021.

At **Hunter's Creek Middle**, interior painting campus-wide is scheduled for 2021.

At **John Young Elementary**, a Curb Appeal project was completed in January 2020.

A comprehensive renovation was completed at **Lake George Elementary** for the 2019-20 school year.

At **Lancaster Elementary**, a tot lot playground shade structure was installed in June 2020.

Construction is underway on the campus that will consolidate Gateway and Cherokee schools into a **Learning Center** adjacent to the Magnolia School site. The custom-designed new school will open in 2021 and will include on-site vocational options, core spaces including classrooms, administrative area, lab spaces, a cafeteria, media center and covered play space and playground.

A tot lot playground shade structure was installed at **McCoy Elementary** in December 2019.

At **Meadow Woods Elementary**, a tot lot playground shade structure was installed in December 2019.

Meadow Woods Middle is under construction for a comprehensive renovation that includes remodeling/refurbishment of buildings 1 through 8, including classrooms, administration, art, music, cafeteria/multi-purpose room, media center, gymnasium and associated interior and site work. The project will be complete in August 2021.

Oakshire Elementary is in the midst of a capital renewal project that includes a new heating, ventilation and air conditioning system, electrical and plumbing improvements, new outside drinking fountains, new canopy and courtyard lighting, new gutters and downspouts as well as new fire alarm, intercom and intrusion detection systems. The project is set to be completed in September 2020. In addition, a tot lot playground shade structure was installed in August 2020.

The new **Pershing School** opened for the 2019-20 school year. The K-8 combined the student bodies of Pershing and Pine Castle elementary schools and added middle school students for the first time.

At **Sally Ride Elementary**, a tot lot playground shade structure was installed in August 2019.

At **Shenandoah Elementary**, exterior painting campus-wide is scheduled for 2021. Replacement of air conditioning chillers is scheduled for 2021.

Site 30-E-SE-3 is an elementary school in design in the Meadow Woods/Boggy Creek area. It is expected to provide relief for Oakshire, Wetherbee, and Wyndham Lakes elementary schools. This project includes construction of a two-story prototype elementary school building with classrooms, administration, art, music, kitchen, cafeteria/multi-purpose room, media center, bus and car loops and the latest classroom technology.

Site 80-H-SW-4 is a new, not-yet-named high school campus planned to open in 2021 in the Dr. Phillips area. It will provide relief to Dr. Phillips and Freedom high schools. The school construction is well underway and includes classrooms, labs, administration, cafeteria, auditorium, and media center. The school will also have the latest classroom technology, athletics amenities and separate bus and car loops.

Southwood Elementary received new gutters and downspouts, air conditioning and plumbing improvements, a new intercom system and new outside drinking fountains in a project that concluded in November 2019. In addition, a new tot lot playground shade structure was installed in June 2020. Exterior painting campus-wide is scheduled for 2021.

A new school in the southeast Orlando/Lee Vista area opened for the 2020-21 school year. **Vista Pointe Elementary** includes classrooms, administration, cafetorium, and media center. The also has the latest classroom technology, updated play areas and new bus and car loops.

At **Waterbridge Elementary**, a tot lot playground shade structure was installed in July 2020.

At **Wetherbee Elementary**, a tot lot playground shade structure was installed in June 2020.

Winegard Elementary opened for the 2020-21 school year with a new main building that houses classrooms, administration, cafetorium, and media center, as well as a renovated Building 3. The school also has the latest classroom technology, updated play areas and new bus and car loops.

A tot lot playground shade structure was installed at **Wyndham Lakes Elementary** in December 2019.
