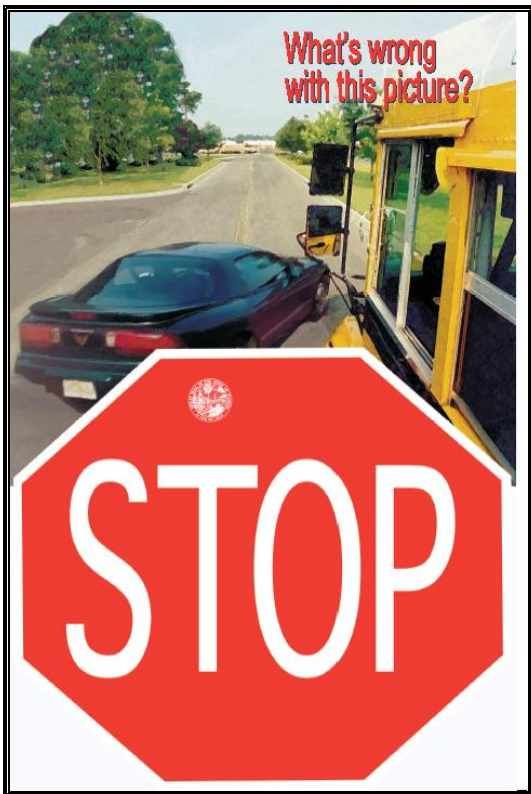


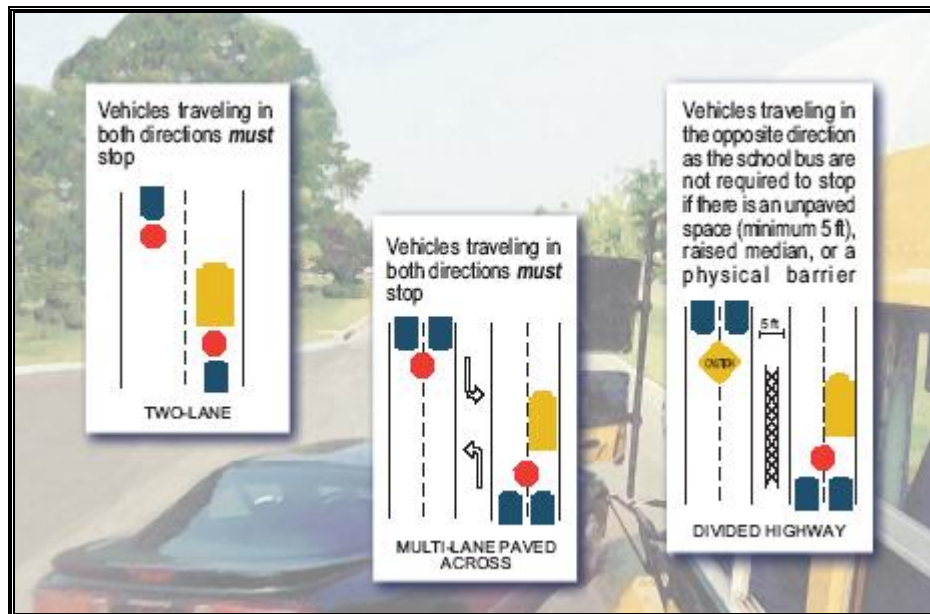
Stopping for School Buses: It's More Than Just the Law, It's a Child's Life



In a 180-day school year, it is estimated that there are almost two million illegal “pass-by’s” of Florida school buses, each representing the possibility of tragic injuries or fatalities to students.

Florida Motor Vehicle Laws require that motorists stop upon approaching any school bus which displays its flashing red lights and has its stop signs extended.

Below are illustrations describing when motorists must stop and when motorists may proceed when a school bus is stopped and displaying its stop signals.



Please remain alert throughout the school year and remember, the inconvenience of an extra few seconds spent waiting for a stopped school bus is insignificant compared to the loss of a child's life.
