

**BOARD ELECTIONS****FILE: BBBG****TITLE:** Membership of the School Board**POLICY:**

The Orange County School Board consists of eight members. The eighth member is a district-wide elected board chair. The other seven members shall have been elected only by the qualified electors who reside in the same district as the member serves. The seven members are elected for a term of four years and shall maintain residence in the district in which they are elected throughout the duration of their term in office. The district-wide elected board chair must reside within Orange County and is elected for a term of four years. Four members shall be elected at the time of the presidential election and three members plus the board chair shall be elected at the time of the gubernatorial election. An office of a school board member shall be vacated when such member removes their residence from the district which they were elected. Any vacancy on the school board shall be filled by the governor's appointment.
