**TITLE:** Organization and Officers

**POLICY:**

- (1) The district school board chair shall be elected as an additional school board member by district-wide vote submitted to and approved by a majority of qualified electors in Orange County, Florida. If a vacancy occurs in the chairmanship, the position shall be filled as provided by law.
- (2) The vice-chair of the district school board shall be elected annually by the members of the school board at their organizational meeting held on the third Tuesday after the first Monday in November. If a vacancy occurs in the vice-chairmanship, the school board shall elect a vice-chair at the next regular or special meeting.
- (3) The chair shall preside at all school board meetings, appoint committees and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by Florida Statutes or by action of the school board. The vice chair shall preside in the absence of the chair and shall perform such other duties of the chair as required by circumstances. The chair and vice chair shall be bonded in the manner prescribed by the State Board of Education.
- (4) The superintendent shall be the secretary and executive officer of the school board, as provided by law. The superintendent may request various personnel employed by the school board to provide information and data relative to their work as may be required in the performance of the superintendent's duties and responsibilities.
