

PUBLIC SALES CALLS AND DEMONSTRATIONS

TITLE: Agents, Solicitors, and Salespersons

POLICY:

Agents, solicitors, and salespersons may visit schools and/or other facilities owned or operated by the School Board of Orange County, Florida ("Board") if the visits are legitimate and are for the purpose of demonstrating products and methods. The following rules shall be observed.

- (1) Principals and/or Department Heads shall exercise judgment as to the merit of any such calls and shall issue written permission when deemed necessary for such a call to be made on employees.
- (2) Principals and/or Department Heads shall prohibit all forms of canvassing or soliciting of teachers or students or employees on school premises during school or business hours.
- (3) Teachers and/or employees shall not to be used as a captive audience for sales promotion.
- (4) Principals and/or Department Heads shall be responsible for compliance with this policy within the confines of their facilities or departments.
- (5) All employees and vendors or potential vendors shall comply with Board policies, including Policy KCE, the Ethics and Lobbying Policy.
