BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS INSPECTIONS

TITLE: Building Inspections

POLICY:

All school buildings shall be inspected at least once during each school fiscal year by a person who is certified by the Florida Department of Education to perform such inspections. Inspections shall be conducted to determine compliance with State Board of Education Rules Chapter 6A-2 and the rules and regulations of any other regulatory agency having jurisdiction over the school system. A copy of such inspection report(s) shall be submitted to the principal, superintendent and school board as applicable.

- (1) Deficiencies reported that are determined to be an immediate danger to life shall be corrected immediately. The school board shall be advised of such deficiencies and of corrective action. Other hazardous conditions shall be corrected in the following priority:
 - (a) Causative factors of fire, accidents and contagion.
 - (b) Effective egress of facilities.
 - (c) Early detection of fire.
 - (d) Prevention of the spread of fire and unsanitary conditions.
 - (e) Fire protection equipment, machine guarding and personal protection.
