Q: A student has marked 'YES' on the FAFSA indicating they are a homeless unaccompanied youth. What kind of documentation is required to satisfy the verification requirement?



A: The McKinney-Vento Program provides FAFSA letters for all identified Unaccompanied Homeless Youth. These letters have been sent to school based coordinators. If additional UHY have been identified since the disbursement or if you are in need of a verification letter for the FAFSA. please email **Cindy** Sawyer.
