## Keys to success for School Based Coordinators

- ⇒ *MVP Binder* - Keep a binder of the SRQ's in your office. This highly confidential form should not be kept in the cumulative file.
- ⇒ *Collaborate* - Students experiencing homelessness often need additional support from adults in their lives. Know your cafeteria manager, school social worker, transportation router, and the Homeless Education liaison.
