### Did you know?

The McKinney-Vento Act provides students experiencing homelessness with the right to:

- 1. Immediate Enrollment (even without normally required documents)
- 2. Free Lunch
- 3. Continue at the school they attended before becoming homeless or the last school attended, if in their best interest.
- 4. Request transportation to remain at the same school
- 5. Have enrollment disputes heard and resolved while the student attends class

Please remember to indicate housing status under the Enrollment tab and Federal Information tab. All supplemental services can only be provided for students who are coded accurately. These codes assist OCPS in compliance with federal guidelines and receiving additional funding for students.
