




<p>1. Open the Google Chrome browser.</p> <p>Note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ClassLink LaunchPad is compatible with:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Chrome○ Edge○ Safari	
<p>2. Login to the Google Chrome Browser with your OCPS account,</p> <p>Note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Logging in to the Chrome browser will automatically install the ClassLink Chrome browser extension.• The ClassLink browser extension does not do anything when you click on it, but it needs to be installed to save passwords on the ClassLink dashboard.• The ClassLink extension stores passwords only for the school-issued apps that are listed on the ClassLink screen.• It does not store other personal passwords, such as a parent's email password, Netflix, Amazon, or banking passwords.	 <p>The image shows two screenshots from a Chrome browser. 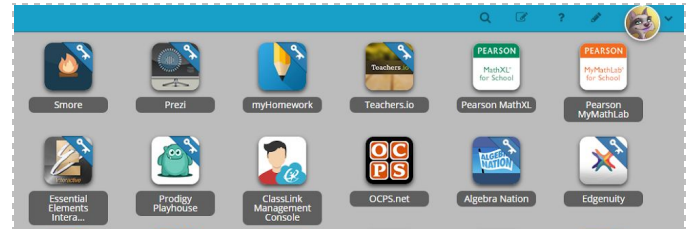

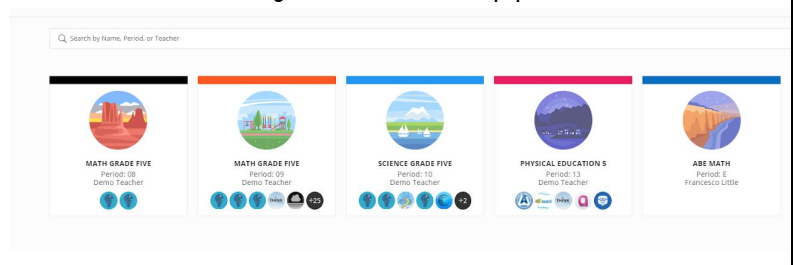
5. Select the **app** you wish to access from the **My Apps** screen.

- The search bar at the top of the screen can be used to enter the name of the app..



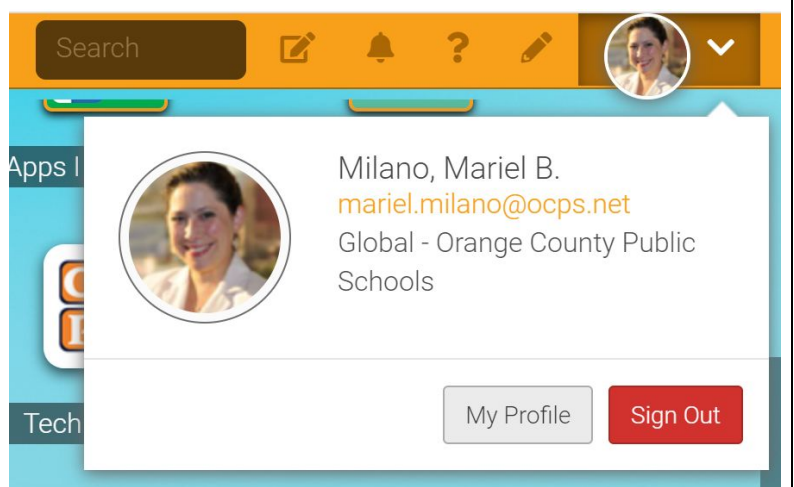
My BackPack App
