# Frequently Asked Question Dr. Phillips/Freedom Relief High School 

Q: When will the school open?

A: August, 2021

Q: What is the name of the school?

A: The school does not have a name yet. Beginning in September of 2020, students, staff, parents, and community members will give input as to potential names. A committee will be formed to narrow those names to 3-5 names. Later in the fall, the community will vote and send the top three names to the OCPS School Board to vote on the new name. That is expected to happen sometime in December 2020 or January 2021. If you are interested in participating in the naming committee, please contact the principal to volunteer.

Q: What is the mascot and the school colors?

A: Those will be determined after the school receives a name.

Q: How many students will the campus hold?

A: 2776 student stations are designed into the building

Q: What grade levels will the school start with on opening day?

A: The school will open in 2021 with grades 9-11. The following year will include a senior class graduating in 2023

Q: What is the attendance zone for the school?

A: That is still to be determined. The next school board work session regarding the attendance zone is on September 15, 2020 at 4:30 pm. All school board work sessions are open to the public.

Q: Will the school have any magnets or academies?

A: There are no magnets planned at this time.

Q: Will the school have varsity athletics?

A: Yes, a full slate of varsity athletics will be available.

Q: Will the school have ROTC?

A: We are hoping to have ROTC in time for school to open.

Q: Will the school have clubs?

A: Absolutely. Clubs are student driven. Students who are interested in starting a club should contact the principal.

Q: When will construction finish?

A: Construction is slated to finish sometime in May. The admin team should be able to move in not long afterwards.
