

State Legislative Session 2019 Update

Budget

- Base Student Allocation increases by \$75 (the discretionary share of a \$248 per student funding increase)
- Last year, the Base Student Allocation increased by \$0.47

Empowerment Scholarship

- Statewide voucher program allows scholarships to attend private schools
 - Limited to families of four with incomes under \$77,000
- Best and Brightest teacher and principal bonus no longer based on SAT and ACT scores

Public Safety Update

• Allows teachers to volunteer to be armed if local school boards adopt the program
