#### **WARNING SYSTEMS**

**TITLE:** Fire Alarm System

### POLICY:

The facility site administrator is responsible for ensuring the fire alarm system is functioning as designed. Facility fire alarm systems are to be tested on a monthly basis. Any malfunction of the fire alarm system shall be immediately reported through the Work Order Notification Action (WNA) system. Reported repairs shall be made without delay. An inability to make prompt repairs shall be reported to the Director - Fire, Health and Safety (Chief Fire Official) by the senior school administrator.

**TITLE:** False Fire Alarms at Educational Facilities

## **POLICY:**

The school administrator shall be responsible for instructing school staff, who in turn shall be responsible for instructing their students, that a deliberate false fire alarm by any person and/or any person who willfully and maliciously disables, destroys, removes or in any manner interferes with the use of any vehicles, tools, equipment, water supplies, hydrants, towers, buildings, communication facilities or other instruments or facilities used in the detection, reporting, suppression or extinguishment of fire shall be guilty up to a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in state statute.
