AUTHORIZED USE OF SCHOOL EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS

TITLE: Student Production of Services and Materials

POLICY:

(1) Students may produce services and materials in the schools only when such production furthers such student's educational development. Costs of services and products produced in school shops and laboratories for nonschool use or consumption shall be borne by the user or consumer when such costs are over and beyond normal instructional and material costs.

- (2) Priorities for availability of services and products for non-school use (such as servicing automobiles or providing cosmetology services) shall be as follows:
 - (a) Students of the school
 - (b) adults other than school system employees and school board members
 - (c) school system employees provided there is no conflict of interest

TITLE: Personal Use of District-Owned Vehicles

POLICY:

The Superintendent or designee may assign certain employees the responsibility of driving a district-owned, operated or controlled vehicle to their residence after duty hours. This shall be an employment condition and the vehicle shall only be driven to the employee's residence or an approved work center and returned to the school or work center for use during the duty day. The use of district-owned vehicles for personal use shall be prohibited.
