## PRE-PAID SCHOOL IMPACT FEE & MITIGATION FORM

A Capacity Enhancement Agreement (CEA) (f/k/a Public Education Agreement (PEA)) may require property owners and developers to pre-pay School Impact and Mitigation Fees at some point in the development process prior to plat approval or issuance of a building permit. This form must be completed and returned to the Department of Facilities Planning at Orange County Public Schools (OCPS) with a check payable to the applicable local government in the amount of the estimated pre-paid School Impact Fees, along with any applicable Capital Contribution payable to OCPS. ## **Footnotes:**

- 1. List all parcel identification numbers assigned to the parcels within the Preliminary Subdivision Plan (PSP), site plan, or plat boundaries that apply to this application. List parcel IDs in a separate attachment, if necessary.
- 2. Development permit type state whether the credit will be applied to a plat, PSP, site plan, or other type of permit required by local government. Only one development permit type should apply. A separate Prepaid School Impact Fee & Mitigation Form must be completed for each development permit application.
- 3. State the title of the PSP, site plan, master plan or plat exactly as it appears on that document. Include assigned case number if applicable.
- 4. Either the CEA or your Capacity Determination application signed by the Applicable Local Government will have the number of residential units that were vested from the capacity enhancement process. Please note that the payment schedule may be different for vested and non-vested units.
- 5. Multi-Family High Rise rate is effective June 22, 2021.
- 6. A CEA may require the payment of an additional contribution (Capital Contribution). Pursuant to a resolution adopted by the School Board on April 12, 2005, the additional contribution may have been waived for CEAs approved prior to this date. Please check with OCPS Facilities Planning to determine whether the additional contribution is applicable. The April 12, 2005 resolution is available at http://planning.ocps.net.
